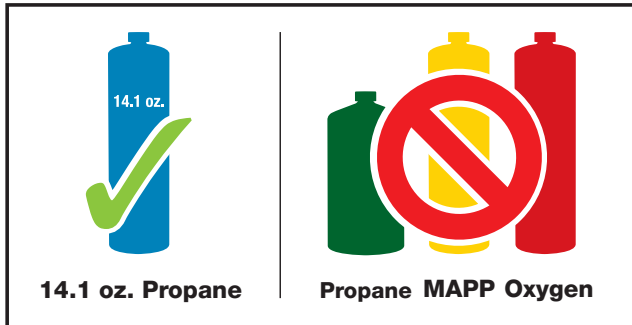


IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS



14.1 oz. Propane

Propane MAPP Oxygen

⚠ WARNING

Only use standard-long blue 14.1 oz. propane cylinder. Using the **WRONG** Cylinder or Gas may result in flare-ups which can result in **SERIOUS INJURY or DEATH.**

Always inspect the threaded outlet of the propane fuel cylinder and remove any dirt that may be there. Improper attachment of the propane gas cylinder to the fogger may result in a gas leak. Care must be taken not to cross thread when attaching the cylinder into the valve.



ALWAYS KEEP FOGGER LEVEL

⚠ WARNING

Do not tilt fogger while using!
A RISK of flare up may occur.
The nozzle tip is naturally angled slightly down.



ALWAYS KEEP FOGGER LEVEL

⚠ WARNING

Do not stand in front of the fogger or point at others while heating or in use. Doing so can result in **SERIOUS INJURY or DEATH.**



ALWAYS KEEP FOGGER LEVEL

⚠ CAUTION

Do not pump while coil is cool.

Pumping while cool will cause liquid to be ejected.

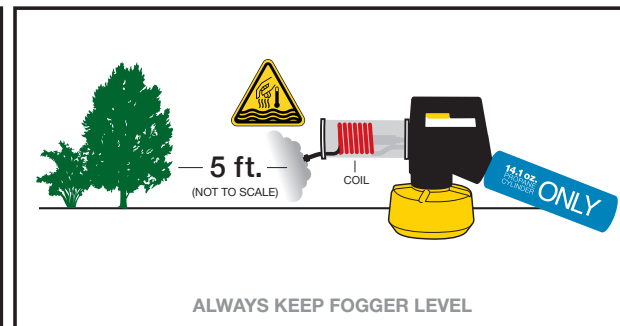
⚠ CAUTION

Allow fogger to properly heat prior to pumping!

Ejecting liquid while heating is normal.

NOTICE

Fogger is ready when coils are glowing red.



ALWAYS KEEP FOGGER LEVEL

NOTICE

Maintain 5' distance (min.) from the nozzle tip to any surface or ornamental plant!

FOR YOUR SAFETY

If you smell gas:

1. Do not attempt to light fogger.
2. Extinguish any open flame.
3. Disconnect from fuel supply.
4. Wait for gas smell to dissipate before attempting to light again.

⚠ DANGER

DO NOT USE indoors!

Operating the fogger in an enclosed area, where fog can become heavily concentrated, may cause fire or explosion, which can result in **SERIOUS INJURY or DEATH.**
